It has been a privilege bringing them on this camp.



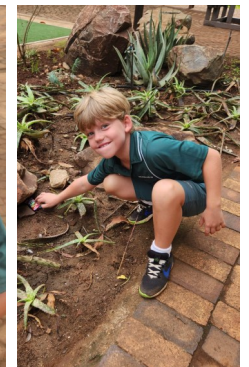
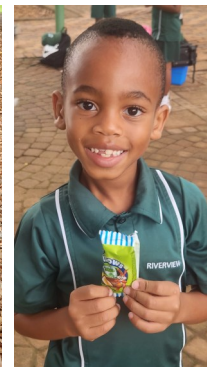
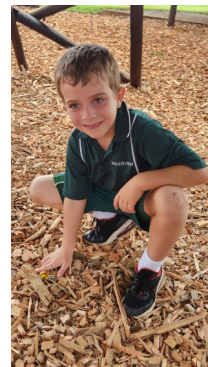
Junior Primary Dr Seuss Week
