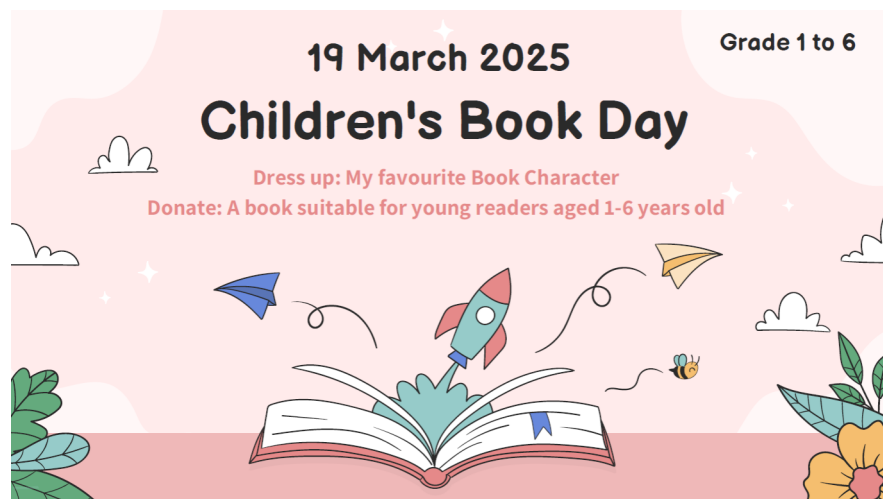
From the Sport's Desk

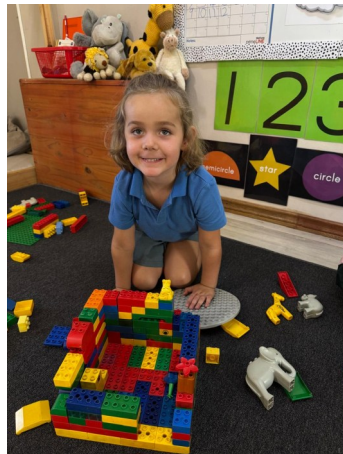


Pre-Primary News
